# Inaugural Be Frank: Youth Programme Prize Presentation

KUALA LUMPUR, [20 NOVEMBER 2013] – Cancer Research Initiatives Foundation (CARIF) recently held its inaugural "Be Frank. Help Beat Cancer: Youth Programme" Prize Presentation at Taylor's University Lakeside Campus in Subang Jaya. The Prize Presentation is the culmination of a 3-month programme to raise awareness of cancer among Malaysian youths.

This programme, funded by the Berjaya Cares Foundation through CARIF, saw university and college students design posters, create videos and and conceptualize games which delivered key cancer awareness messages to their fellow peers.

These campaigns reached the wider community through Facebook, blogs and cancer awareness carnivals at Sunway University and Taylor's University. To date, the "Be Frank: Youth Programme" has reached out to more than 2,000 youths.

"We are very happy to receive this award. This programme has given us the opportunity to increase cancer awareness through "out of the box ideas". It made it possible for us to help make a difference in fighting cancer," said Janesh Nathan from A-levels programme, Sunway University and the group leader from team Cherish.
