SCOPE / PURPOSE OF JOB

RESPONSBILITIES

- Develop and implement an integrated strategic communications plan to advance CRMY's brand identity; broaden awareness of its programs and priorities; and increase the visibility of its programs across key stakeholder audiences as well as cultivate and enhance meaningful relationships with targeted, high-level external audiences, including the media and key influencers.
- Oversee the day-to-day activities of the communications function which includes to write, produce and develop content for all CRMY print materials such as the annual report, marketing collaterals and electronic communications including CRMY's website and social media network; manage relationships with associated vendors.
- Actively engage, cultivate and manage press relationships including to prioritize media opportunities, and prepare talking points, speeches, presentations and other supporting material as needed to ensure coverage surrounding CRMY's programs, special events, public announcements, and other projects.
- Conceptualize, research, promote and execute campaigns and events such as workshops, seminars, talks and exhibitions which include, but not limited to, Reverse Cancer Day, World Cancer Day, World Survivor's Day, World Cancer Research Day, Pink October, fundraising activities, volunteer and donor appreciation day and so on.
- Assist the Chief Operating Officer to manage the communications team (events, digital and social media, and outreach) to support the development and execution of the communications strategy, events, outreach programs and sponsorship marketing.
