Over more than 20 years, Cancer Research Malaysia (CRMY) has done study and research on cancer cell lines in Asian patients, and found that cancer cells in Asians react differently compared to the Caucasian cancer cell lines. Today, scientists of Cancer Research Malaysia have found and developed the Asian Risk Calculator (ARiCa), Mobile Mouth Screening Anywhere (MeMoSA®) Digital Health Platform, and an oral cancer vaccine which is moving towards clinical trials.
