

## Race Against Cancer Run 2026 Returns to Kuala Lumpur, Rallying Community Support for Life-Saving Research

KUALA LUMPUR, 29 March 2026 – Cancer Research Malaysia (CRM) is set to bring back its flagship Race Against Cancer (RAC) Run 2026, uniting individuals, families, and corporate partners in a meaningful movement to support cancer research and community programmes.

Held at Kepong Metropolitan Park, the event marked its third run and its debut in Kuala Lumpur. The charity run welcomed approximately 1,600 participants, all coming together with a shared purpose: to take strides towards a cancer-free future.
